* Student Check in Backstage Required 30 Minutes before showtime. Auditorium Doors open 15 minutes before Showtime. Show length is about an hour.

Show Week: All Rehearsals are held at Ponte Vedra High School. NO CLASSES AT REGULAR LOCATIONS.

<u>REQUIRED Technical Rehearsal:</u> Tuesday, November 18th - This important rehearsal will give the students a chance to become familiar with the space, before all the distractions of stage lighting and costumes. Wear your regular dancewear. Be on time, we are on a tight schedule!

4:30-5:30 - Friday Kittens & Kubs, Aberdeen Kittens & Kubs, JCP Kubs - Flowers, Butterflies, Cats, Bluebirds / Bows

5:00-5:30 - JCP Kittens, Bartram Kittens - Rabbits / Bows

5:30-6:00 – Aberdeen Kats, JCP Kats - Jazzy Garden Flowers/Won't You Join the Dance/Bows

6:00-6:30 - Bartram Kubs & Kats - Caterpillar Island/ Bows

6:30-7:30 - Characters, JCP Kougars - Get to Wonderland/If You Dare/Alice & March of the Cards/Queen of Hearts Flamingo Croquet/Up the Rabbit Hole/ Bows

7:30-8:00 – Friday Kats & Kougars Alice Medley / White Rabbit's Rush / Bows

8:00-8:45 - Characters - Cheshire/Tweedles/Tea Time/Get to Wonderland Reprise/Bows

Rehearsal Reminders:

- Parents can wait in the audience until your child is called to the stage (for Technical Rehearsal).
 Please do not bring guests to Rehearsals unless specially requested and anyone sitting in the audience MUST be quiet! Please don't be offended if you are asked to step outside because of noise.
- No Food in the Auditorium during Rehearsals, Only Water. No Gum.
- Please give yourself plenty of time to arrive, park, visit the bathroom and be ready. Children will pick up on your stress! Set the example...be happy and calm

 Rehearsal and Performance days are not the days for playing out in the hot sun or vigorous activity. Help them make the most of their exciting event by getting plenty of rest and good nourishment. They worked very hard to get to this day! Go celebrate afterwards...create some good memories!

REQUIRED Dress Rehearsal: Friday, November 21st – Show #1 – 4:30-6:30pm Show #2 – 6:30-8:30pm

- * Full Costume, Hair up and makeup! Dress Rehearsal will run in the order of the show.
- * Some dancers that are in both shows will be released earlier than the full rehearsal time.

Steps to Follow at Dress Rehearsal AND the Show:

- 1. Arrive on time, calm, not stressed...children will pick up on your mood! Dancers should arrive with makeup and hair complete with hairpiece and tights on to simplify.
- 2. Bring your costume, any accessories and dance shoes with you to the theater.
- 3. Upon arriving, take your child to the restroom in the lobby so we have no accidents!
- 4. Afterwards, enter the outside Backstage Door and into the Changing Room (Girls only) on your immediate left. Change into costume (you may also change your dancer into costume in the restroom if you choose). Leave your Garment Bag with Name Tag in this room to change after the rehearsal/show or you can leave them in costume to travel home if you choose! (Kool Kats and Kougars will change in their dressing rooms).
- 5. Proceed down the hallway to the Check-In table. Kisses and Hugs to your dancer and tell them how excited you are to watch them dance and you'll see them just as soon as they are done! It's best NOT to linger. NO Parents Allowed beyond the check in table. We have "Stage Mama Kats" assigned to each class and they have prepared a fun, theater adventure for your child, so relax and enjoy the show...your dancers are in good hands!
- 6. Relax quietly in the audience. Take photos/video as you please, but NOT at the Show!
- 7. After your child has finished rehearsing at Dress Rehearsal, return to the backstage hallway where your 'Stage Mama Kat' will bring your dancers for pickup.
- 8. After the show, Dancers will be released from the front of the stage to a parent...listen for directions.
- 9. After the fun Auditorium Post Show Activities, Return to the changing room in the backstage hallway to change and collect your things.
- 10. REPEAT FOR THE SHOW!

<u>Costumes/Shoes:</u> Costumes will be sent home as they arrive...Performance tights are included and will be handed out in November! Keep costumes in a safe place away from pets! Label all your items, hang on hanger to let the wrinkles fall out and cover with a garment bag. Keep accessories in a plastic bag on the hanger. Any borrowed costumes will be waiting for you at the theater. Please leave borrowed costumes on the garment rack in the dressing area after dress rehearsal and at the end of the show. <u>Please label shoes inside with your dancer's name.</u> Kittens and Kubs – pink leather ballet slippers w/no drawstring. If your class needs different shoes, they will be informed.

Hair: Hair must be confined up off of the neck in a classical style high bun unless your particular class has been asked to have a different hairstyle. Use bobby pins, gel, hairspray and a hairnet, along with damp hair to help hair stay in place. Bangs generally look better onstage when they are combed back. Very short hair should be pulled away from the face with barrettes. No colored hair accessories other than those that come with your costume. No colored hair please!

<u>Makeup:</u> It's purpose is to help the dancer's faces show up on stage. Parents, use your own discretion in regards to makeup. Suggestions: foundation or concealer to even out skin tones and add color, blush, natural looking eyeshadow (no blue or glitter), mascara, eyebrow pencil, powder to reduce shine and rosy/reddish lipstick. No glitter makeup please. No necklaces, rings, etc. only small, stud earrings. No crazy nail polish! No panties under tights. <u>Practice Hair and Makeup at dress rehearsal, so you can see what will need adjusting for the show.</u>

<u>Tickets:</u> Tickets go on sale Saturday November 1st, 9:00 am. You must order and choose your seats online.

To Order: Click the link on our Website or go directly to www.23838.recitalticketing.com/ Tickets are \$15 or \$25 Premium plus ticket fee and applicable tax. No limit, order as many as you need. Seats will be available until showtime and must be purchased online.

We are having two shows, each with the same program, but with different casts. You are going to enjoy it so much, we know you'll want to see it again! and you can...for FREE!! Any ticket buyer may attend a 2nd show and have FREE seating in the risers (balcony) including dancers. Please bring your dancer, they will LOVE it! If you would rather choose a closer seat for your 2nd show, just choose the seats you want to purchase and they will automatically be discounted 50%! (Tickets must be purchased at the same time for the 50% discount).

Ticket Tips:

- * Be warned, they sell fast! Plan ahead of time to get the seat you want.
- * Have all your payment information ready as there is a time limit on your shopping cart.
- * Make sure to purchase tickets for the correct show!
