



## 2019/20 Season Dance Tuition and Policies

**Current Dance Season runs through our Stage Production November 2020! June/July Summer Break.**

**PLEASE NOTE:** The majority of our studio communication is done by email and through your Parent Portal. Please make sure we have your correct email address on file and check it periodically for dance news and reminders. We update our database each season, so log in and make sure we have up to date contact information for you. We don't want you to miss out on any exciting news!

### **Classes are held weekly at your location.**

Class Enrollment must be at least 5 students or may be subject to cancellation.

**Monthly Tuition Installments as follows:** per student.....siblings receive a 50% discount off tuition!

Level 1 Kuddly Kittens...ages 3-5....\$65 per month.....45 min. class.....Creative Dance Adventures  
Level 2 Kute Kubs...ages 5-7. ....\$75 per month.....1 hour class.....Creative Dance Adventures  
Level 3 Kool Kats...ages 8-10 .....\$75 per month.....1 hour class.....Ballet/Jazz Dance  
Level 4 Kreative Kougars...11 up....\$85 per month....1.15 hour class...Ballet/Jazz/Musical Theater

**100% Happiness Guarantee – If you find at your first class that it is not a good fit for you, we will refund your payment in full!**

- **Annual Registration Fee \$30 per student, (Siblings \$20)**
- **\*Tuition is due at the BEGINNING of each month \* Statements are emailed each month. If paid after the 10<sup>th</sup> of the month, a \$10 fee will be automatically added. Insufficient Funds Fee \$25**
- **10% Discount if paying the Season in Full, on top of sibling discount! (must be paid at first class)**
- Tuition is non-refundable and customarily pro-rated for the first month only. Missed classes may be made up. Tuition is monthly and is not based on the number of weeks in a month. Some months will have 5 lessons, some less.
- Payments made through the Parent Portal will have a 3% Convenience Fee added automatically. If you wish to avoid this, you can make payment at class, in person by check, cash or money order in a marked envelope with your child's name. Online payments are encouraged as you will have an immediate receipt of your payment and the added convenience. AUTOPAY is conveniently available through your Parent Portal.

- Tuition must be kept up to date. Student's whose account is more than 2 weeks overdue will be asked to watch class and not participate until the account can be made current or arrangements are made with Mrs. Kathy. Performance Costumes will not be sent home until your account is current. Feel free to contact Mrs. Kat to make arrangements if you run into a bind.
- Our season runs until November 2020 with June/July off. In the case of cancellation, notification must be in writing before the 1<sup>st</sup> calendar day of the month or you will be responsible for the full month's tuition charge. We offer separate fun Summer Programs!

**\*Performance Fee \$180 per student (\$120 each sibling) ½ Due April 15<sup>th</sup>, ½ Due September 15<sup>th</sup>**

**Hair:** Must be secured off the neck, preferred in a bun.

- ❖ **Holiday Closings** - We normally follow the School Calendar of the district the dance class is held in. NO classes November 27<sup>th</sup>-29<sup>th</sup>, December 23<sup>rd</sup>-Jan. 3<sup>rd</sup>, March Spring Break to be announced.
- ❖ **Invite a Friend Week – Week of October 21<sup>st</sup>**
- ❖ **Parent Observation Days – Week of December 16<sup>th</sup>, to be announced**
- ❖ In cases of cancelled class due to Weather or other unavoidable circumstances, we will do our best to make up the class. In some cases, it may not be possible. We do not typically make up dance days that are caused by the closure of a facility we are teaching at.
- ❖ **Regular, punctual attendance is IMPORTANT!** Much planning goes into creating paced and progressive classes. Students will have gaps in their training when they miss class or are late and it will make things difficult for them, their classmates and the teacher. Students need the support of parents in this area and excessive absence can result in loss of dance privileges, in particular, at showtime. Missed classes can be made up, just ask me for recommendations.
